

Greetings of Peace and Solidarity!

In line with our continuing effort to help enhance the digital literacy of our youth, The Cyber Knowledge Computer Tutorial Services has conceived the initiative to offer a field tutorial service designed to succors the students to be equipped and updated towards information technology relevant to globalization.

To help us determine the proficiency level and interest of the students in the field of information technology, a 5-minute short survey will be administered to all Grade 5 to Grade 7 students. Should there be interested participants, and upon proper coordination with the LGU and barangay officials, we shall conduct a separate meeting with their parents or guardians to provide the full details of the activity.

The proposed tutorials will be held once a week (either Saturday or Sunday only) and will take place in affiliated computer laboratories. These sessions will be handled by experienced IT instructors. The tutorial sessions include hands-on learning using the "One Student – One Computer" approach, and covers topics such as Typing Master, Microsoft Office applications (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Publisher), basic internet use, and—for advanced learners—Adobe Photoshop, basic programming, video/photo editing, and troubleshooting. However, the participation of the parents here is only the service fee for the computer instructors while all learning modules and handouts are provided for free. Upon completion, students will receive a Certificate of Completion that may support their future academic or career interests.

The Cyber Knowledge overview the outcome of the activity that the students will have a wider knowledge in gaining and accessing educational information, handle and manage data, design and present several forms of information. Through these skills our students will become more useful and productive citizens in this age of technology. We believe that having advanced computer skills is a significant asset to our youth nowadays.

This tutorial service is very essential for the youth, but it is not compulsory or obligatory on the part of the parent's concern. It depends upon the discretion of the interested participants and on a voluntary basis only.

We assure you that this activity will be conducted with full respect to DepEd guidelines and will not interfere with regular school activities.

In this regard, the Cyber Knowledge Computer Tutorial Service is respectfully requesting permission to allow us to administer a 5-minute short survey to evaluate the proficiency level and determine the interest of the students in information technology, covering all Grade 5 to Grade 7 students in all schools within the division.
