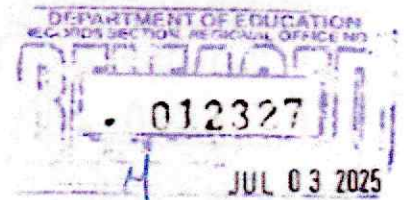

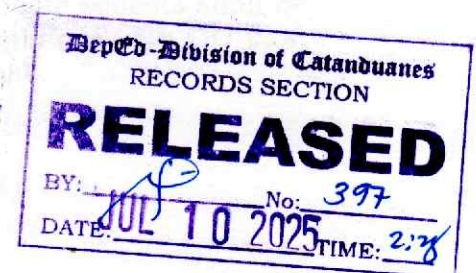

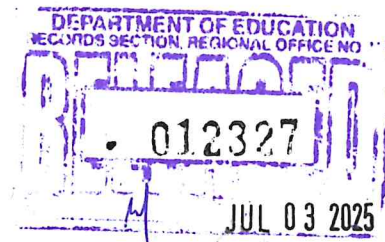

- *Exploring AI's contributions to sustainability, educational equity, and global collaboration*

**6. AI in Educational Leadership and Administration**

- *Examining AI's impact on school management, policymaking, and ethical governance.*

**7. Harnessing Technology for Conflict Resolution and Global Understanding**

- *Utilizing AI to combat misinformation, foster peace education, and uphold human rights.*

Keynote, plenary lectures, and paper presentations will revolve around leading-edge thinking, innovative approaches, and practices about values education and international education for lasting peace; or the gaps where more research and strategies are needed.

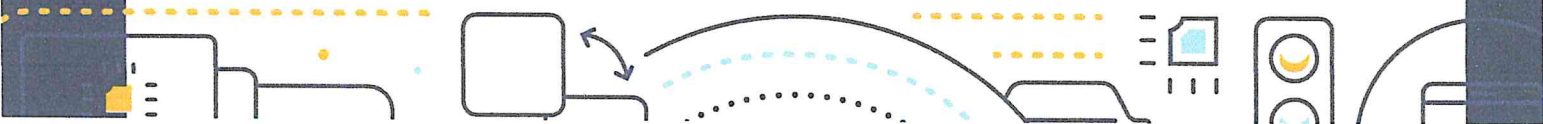
