



Who Can Apply

Applicants must be Filipino citizens and employees from any of the following target sectors:

- Climate and Disaster Resilience Component
 - National government agencies (NGAs) with mandate on climate change (CC) and disaster risk reduction (DRR); and
 - Government agencies with CC and DRR programs.
- Data Science Component:
 - NGAs with mandate/programs on data collection/management relevant to CC and DRR; and
 - Government agencies with CC and DRR programs.



Scholarship Recipients must hold the following qualifications:

Climate and Disaster Resilience Component:

 Identified employees of the nominating agencies;

 DRR and Management Officers/planning and development officers in local government units (LGUs); and

 Persons working in climate adaptation, disaster risk reduction, and sustainability in the government sector.

Data Science Component:

 Identified employees of the nominating agencies;

 Planning and Development Officers, including other officers dealing with science/analytics in LGUs, in relation to CC and DRR; and

 Persons working in sustainability and inclusivity in the government sector.

As a program committed to equal opportunity and diversity across genders and cultures, at least 50% of scholarship slots are reserved for women and members of Indigenous groups.

Documents Needed

 - a. No pending administrative case;
 - Not a recipient of any government scholarship for graduate and post-graduate studies within two (2) years from the time of completion of the scholarship and application with the SLL-CDRR; and
 - c. Performance ratings of at least "very satisfactory" or its equivalent for the two (2) consecutive rating periods immediately preceding the nomination.

Documents Needed

- 5. Duly Notarized Personal Data Sheet (PDS) and Work Experience Sheet as of date of application/nomination;
- 6. Copy of Transcript of Records (undergraduate studies);
- 7. Medical Certificate (fit to study as certified by a licensed government physician);
- 8. Copy of Agency/Company ID and any government-issued ID (preferably passport);
- 9. Valid National Bureau of Investigation clearance; and
- 10. Notarized Pro forma Self-certification of (a) no other active/ongoing academic scholarship grant at the start of the program and (b) non-withdrawal from the EMDRCM/MSDS program without justifiable reason and without prior notice from the AIM, CCC, and his/her agency/organization.
