- 1. Republic Act 11036 "Mental Health Act of 2018", specifically Chapter V, Sec. 24, Mental Health Promotion in Educational Institution, states that, educational institutions, such as schools, colleges, universities, and technical schools, shall develop policies and programs for students, educators, and other employees designed to raise awareness on mental health issues, identified and provide support and services for individuals at risk, and facility access, including referral mechanisms of individual with mental health conditions to treatment and psychosocial support.
- 2. With that, the School Governance and Operations Division-through the School Health and Nutrition Unit, together with DOH-Catanduanes and Abaca Eagles Club, will be conducting a mental health advocacy program with the theme: "Where na you? Here na me... Tara, usap tayo", on January 17, 2024 (Wednesday), from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, at Cobo Integrated School and Pandan School of Arts and Trade.
- 3. The activity aims to reduce stigma surrounding mental health issues, fostering a more accepting and empathetic attitude towards peers experiencing challenges.
- 4. Travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds/division/School MOOE/other fund sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
