- 1. In preparation for the upcoming 2024 Regional Schools Press Conference pursuant to Regional Memorandum 000248, s. 2024, there will be a live in Division Cliniquing-Workshop for the 2024 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) Qualifiers on **March 23-26**, 2024 at Virac Central Elementary School, Virac South District.
- 2. The main objective of the activity is to prepare and train the 2024 RSPC qualifiers in the different individual and group events through workshops and sessions by resource speakers.
- 3. Participants in this cliniquing workshop are the campus journalists and school paper advisers in the **top three** winners (English and Filipino) in the nine individual events and the best team (English and Filipino) in group events in Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting, Collaborative Desktop Publishing, Online Publishing, TV Broadcasting and Scriptwriting, in the elementary and secondary levels, as stipulated in Division Bulletin No. 008, s. 2024.
- 4. Travel, incidental expenses and registration of P 490.00 shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for the meals for four days (breakfast, lunch and dinner) to start on March 23, lunch time until March 26 (lunch), charged to AKO Bicol funds, the remaining amount from the 2024 Division Schools Press Conference and the school's MOOE subject to the accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Registration fee shall be paid to the Cashiers Office c/o Ms. Liza Bernardo.

- 5. Since the activity falls on the scheduled 3rd quarter examination of the learners, consideration is enjoined pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 21, s. 2010 and Regional Memorandum No. 66, s. 2011 on the "Guidelines for rating athletes/campus journalists and other participants in all DepEd Palaro, Cultural, Academic Conference and Contests".
- 6. Considering that March 23 and 24, 2024 fall on Saturday and Sunday, all teacher-participants are entitled to a two-day vacation service credits, in congruence to the provisions set in DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, re: updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. On the other hand, the non-teaching personnel are entitled to receive a Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) for the accrued number of hours rendered on the same dates, as provided in CSC & DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, re: Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered.
- 7. The activity is live in and there are evening sessions, thus participants are advised to stay in Virac Central ES and bring their own beddings. They are also advised to bring their own spoon and fork, and tumbler. In case of those participants who would like to go home after each evening session, a waiver shall be signed, and the school paper adviser shall take full responsibility of the campus journalist and make sure that they will be in time for the morning session the following day.
- 7. All campus journalist shall bring with them signed parent's/guardian's consent.
- 8. Attached are the template for the parent's/guardian's consent, technical working group and the facilitators.
