REITERATION OF DEPED MEMORANDUM NO. 41, s. 2024 "REITERATION OF THE 'NO COLLECTION POLICY' IN SCHOOLS"

- 1. This Office strongly reminds all school officials and personnel to adhere to the "No Collection Policy in Schools" in the Department of Education.
- 2. DepEd Memorandum No. 41, s. 2024 specifies the prohibitions as well as the sanctions for non-compliance to the policy. A copy of the said memorandum is enclosed for easy reference.
- 3. To ensure the compliance of schools to the policy, the Public Schools District Supervisors are requested to render a consolidated report of the collections (of allowed membership fees and PTA contributions) in the schools in their district for School Year 2024-2025. The report must be submitted to the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent on October 11, 2024, through the CID Chief.
- 4. Dissemination of and compliance with this memorandum is required.

REITERATION OF THE "NO COLLECTION POLICY" IN SCHOOLS

- 1. Following Republic Act No. (RA) 4206, also known as "An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities," as amended by RA 5546, the Department of Education (DepEd) issued DepEd Order (DO) No. 19, s. 2008, titled "Implementation of No Collection Policy in All Public Elementary and Secondary Schools," prohibiting the collection of fees from learners during the enrolment period and at any time during the school year.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 1, RA 4206, as amended by RA 5546, it is hereby reiterated that "the sale of tickets and/or the collection of contributions in any form whatsoever, by any person for any project or purpose, whether voluntary or otherwise, from school children, students and teachers of public and private schools, colleges and universities is hereby prohibited: Provided, however, that this prohibition shall not cover membership fees of school children and students the Red Cross, the Girl Scouts of the Philippines and the Boy Scouts of the Philippines: Provided, finally, that this Prohibition shall not cover the contributions of parents and other donors for the support of barrio high schools."
- 3. Section 2, RA 4206, as amended, provides that non-compliance with the aforementioned prohibition shall be penalized with a fine or imprisonment for not more than one month, or both, in the discretion of the court.
- 4. All DepEd personnel are advised of DO No. 49, s. 2022, titled Amendments to DepEd Order No. 047, s. 2022 (Promotion of Professionalism in the Implementation and Delivery of Basic Education and Programs and Services). This directive serves as reminder to DepEd personnel to refrain from unwarranted solicitations and collection of contributions.
- 5. This Order hereby underscores the policy that sales of tickets and/or all forms of contributions, voluntary or otherwise, are prohibited except for the instances provided under RA 4206, as amended.





- All previous issuances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this
 Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- All Regional and Schools Division Offices are instructed to establish their respective monitoring mechanisms and ensure the continuing compliance of schools with aforementioned Department issuances.
- Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
