



REGIONAL YES-O CAMP AND TRAINING

TO: Schools Division Superintendents

1. The Regional Yes-O Camp and Training as mandated in DepED Order 55, 2011 shall be conducted on September 25-27, 2013 at Don Servillano Platon High School, Tinambac, Camarines Sur.
2. Centered on the theme, "Youth: An Advocate of a Green Environment Towards a Better Future," the training/camp aims to:
 - Develop pupils and students' active participation and determine concreteness in the protection, preservation and rehabilitation of the environment;
 - Develop pupils and students' deeper awareness on the state of environment focusing on significant issues and concerns;
