



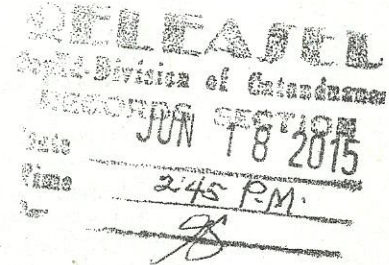

In reference to the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) National Advisory Committee (NAC) resolution No. 18 entitled Continued Support for the Child Beneficiaries of Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program to Finish High School, Section 7: Repetition and Required General Weighted Average (GWA) which states that:

"Children in elementary who repeat a year level in school are allowed to continue with the program. Children in high school are required by the end of the school year to reach the passing GWA prescribed by the Department of Education (DepEd), and/or promoted to the next year level".

To ensure the effective implementation of the program, there will be a switching on the monitoring period 2015 (P3 monitoring period).

Attached is the revised monitoring schedule from the Department of Social Welfare and Development.

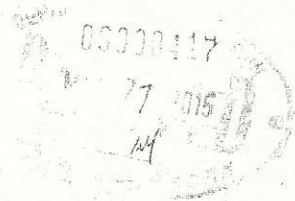

We respectfully inform you that there will be a switching on the monitoring period this coming 2015-16 monitoring period. The systems enhancement aims to streamline the compliance monitoring processes for the continuous improvement of the program implementation. Below were the enhancements that will achieve the following benefits:

- There will be reduction in the operations costs because the CV processes particularly during P2 CV monitoring period will be streamlined. The school summer vacation months (April and May) will be paired up, there will be No CV F2 to be generated during Period 2.
- It will improve cash disbursement because there will be 3 expected payouts which includes March, May, June for the 1st semester.

In order to ensure the effective implementation of this enhancement, our field implementers will coordinate with your Public School District Supervisor to provide information dissemination and training activities for its implementation.
