"Youth, humanitarian loadars of tomorrow"

I. INTRODUCTION

One of the major services of the Philippine Red Cross, the Red Cross Youth aims to develop among the youth the spirit of volunteerism, leadership and service by giving them opportunities to participate in relevant Red Cross activities within the framework of the organization.

The Red Cross Youth Camp has been organized to highlight the important role of the youth in nation building as change agents and leaders. The PRC aims to nurture the youth and provide measures to engage them in activities that will allow them to contribute to productivity and development.

The RCY Camp provides an opportunity to develop a culture of friendship and cooperation among young people as we provide an avenue to meet and understand intercultural characters. We aspire to inspire the youth to live by the movement's fundamental principles and imbued a value-oriented leadership.

RCY Camp is a 3-day camp scheduled per municipal cluster to bring together the youth volunteers of PRC – Catanduanes Chapter. This activity will also highlight the important role the RCY advisers play in nurturing the young minds of our volunteers. PRC – Catanduanes Chapter will conduct the RCY Camp together with the RCY Advisers, as partner camp managers.

The registration fee does not cover the meals and travel expenses of the participant from the school to the venue. However, the council may seek sponsorship from their school, community, civic organization, and local government units if available.
