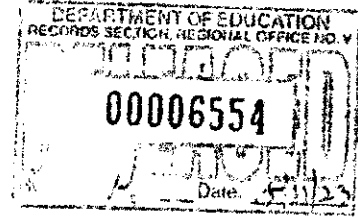

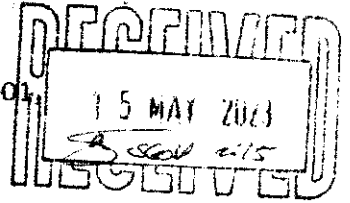
1. Enclosed is the Advisory No. 006 s. 2023 in compliance with depEd order no.8 s. 2013.

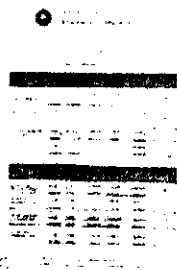

CHED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS AY 2023-2024

CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY

1. Filipino Citizen
2. Graduating high school students/High school graduate
3. General Weighted Average (GWA) of at least 93% or above.
 - o For Full State Scholarship Program(FSSP) and Full Private Education Student Financial Assistance(FPESFA), GWA must be 96 or above
 - o For Half-SSP and Half-PESFA, GWA must be atleast 93 but not more than 95
4. Combined annual gross income of parent/s, guardian for CY 2022 does not exceed Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 400,000.00), or in cases where the income exceeds PHP400,000.00 an applicant must present a written certification or medical findings of illness of a family member, or school certifications of two or more dependents enrolled in college
5. Avail of only one government funded financial assistance program.

DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

Citizenship:

- Original /Certified true copy of Birth Certificate

Academic:

- Front and back image of the duly certified true copy of High school report card for incoming freshmen students eligible for college (High School Graduate)
- Front and back image of the duly certified true copy of grades for Grade 11 and 1st semester of Grade 12 for graduating high school students

Income: - any of the following:

- Latest ITR (BIR Form No. 2316 CY 2022) of parents or guardian if employed
- Certificate of Tax Exemption from the BIR
- Certificate of Indigency from their Barangay named after the parent/guardian indicating the annual income
- Certificate/Case Study from DSWD (not the panunumpa)
- Latest copy of contract or proof of income for children of Overseas Filipino Workers (OFW) and seafarers.

Additional requirement:

- 2x2 picture
