REGIONAL MEMORANDUM No 301 s. 2023

ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) LITERACY MAPPING FOR SY 2023-2024

To Schools Division Superintendents
All others Concerned

- 1. Section 17, paragraph C of RA 11510, also known as the Alternative Learning System Act provides among others on the conduct of literacy mapping to wit: "Ensure the implementation of community literacy mapping activities within the city or municipality and coordinate with the barangays, the private sector and other agencies in the identification of out-of-school children in special cases and adults who have not yet completed their basic education."
- 2. Corollary thereof, the Alternative Learning System (ALS) through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), announces the conduct of Literacy Mapping for SY 2023-2024 in the Schools Division Offices from July 10, 2023 to September 2, 2023.
- 3. All ALS teachers are mandated to conduct literacy mapping activities in their specific areas of assignment utilizing ALS Form 1 Masterlist of Mapped, Potential Learners, while community ALS Implementers—may or may not conduct the mapping activities, but without prejudice to related provisions stated in their contracts or terms of reference (TOR).
- 4. The result of the literacy mapping across all Schools Divisions shall serve as a baseline data on the status of out-of-school children, youth and adults who have not yet completed basic education.
- 5. Updating of mapping results will be done every Monday of the mapping period through on-line Dynamic Google Literacy Mapping forms that will be sent to Division ALS Focal Persons.
