They must be able demonstrate the ability to assess security risks, to formulate security policies, to design security solution, to manage security incident, and to use security technologies.

The capability building on cybersecurity provides the foundational framework on what are considered by rules and standards as the valid concept, principles, organization, life cycle, process, documentation, metrics and technologies of securing the people, data, application and infrastructure of the enterprise or agency against cybercrime and data privacy breach.
