

DepEd Bicol receives Prime HRM certificate from CSC

Legazpi City – The Department of Education Regional Office V formally received its certification from the Civil Service Commission (CSC) for obtaining the Maturity Level 2 of the Enhanced Program to Institutionalize Meritocracy and Excellence in Human Resource Management (PRIME-HRM) under Recruitment, Selection, and Placement (RSP) System.

DepEd Bicol Regional Director Gilbert Sadsad received the certificate of recognition from Civil Service Commission Bicol Regional Director Atty. Daisy Punzalan Bragais and Civil Service Albay Provincial Director Sharon Farida Flores through a hybrid in person and virtual awarding ceremony held on March 8, 2022.

The Program to Institutionalize Meritocracy and Excellence in Human Resource Management (PRIME-HRM) is a mechanism that empowers government agencies by developing their human resource management competencies, systems, and practices toward HR excellence. It is also designed to help elevate public sector human resource management to a level of excellence through a process of assessment, assistance and awarding of HRM systems, practices and competencies using HRM maturity level indicators that meet global standards.

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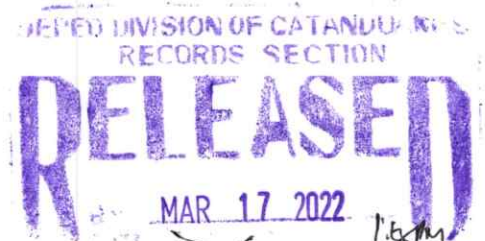
