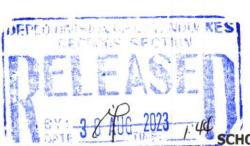

 - a. Letter of Intent;
 - b. Duly accomplished and updated Personal Data Sheet (CS Form 212, Revised 2017) together with the Work Experience Sheet;
 - c. Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including list and description of any qualifying examinations taken/passed, assignments in the past five (5) years, successful programs, projects, and/or work processes initiated/led/accomplished, significant accomplishments and relevant citations/awards received;













- d. Certificates of Eligibility;
- e. Updated Service Record;
- f. Designation Order (if any);
- g. Official Transcript of Records;
- h. CESPES Ratings from the Career Executive Service Board for the last two (2) rating periods (2021 and 2022)
- Self-certification disclosing all administrative/civil/criminal charges, if there are any, together with the executive summary of pending cases, copies of complaints, counter-affidavits, and other supporting documents;
- Duly accomplished Applicant Profile template;
- k. Sworn omnibus certification of authenticity and veracity of all documents submitted; and
- 1. Any other relevant documents.
