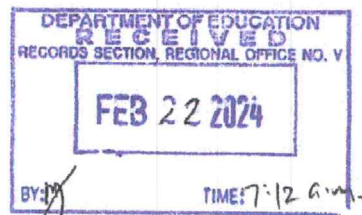

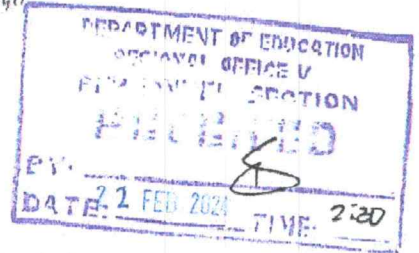

Coverage:

PDFAP is open to all **active PPSTA members** within the Department of Education (DepEd), as well as Local and State Colleges and Universities.

Terms and Conditions:

To avail the PDFAP, members must meet certain criteria, including being a bonafide active member of good standing for at least two years and not exceeding 60 years old. The financial assistance is a one-time benefit of Php15,000.00 and is dedicated to graduate or postgraduate education-related studies, particularly for thesis or dissertation writing.

Procedure:

The application process involves submitting the required documents to the local chapter, with endorsements and approvals proceeding through the regional and national levels. The PDFAP is granted on a first-come, first-served basis, and there are seven grantees per region.

Commitment:

Grantees are required to sign a commitment agreement, pledging to continue their membership and serve in the DepEd for at least one year after availing the benefit.
