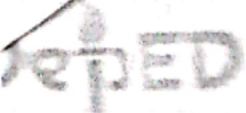

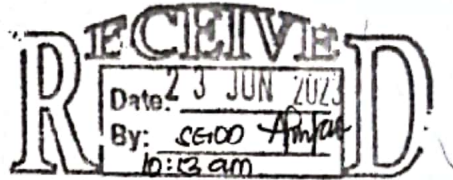

- b. Knowing how the data was collected helps the reader evaluate the validity and reliability of your results, and the conclusions you draw from them.
- c. The research methods must be appropriate to the objectives of the study. If you perform a case study of one commuter in order to investigate users' perceptions of the efficiency of public transport in Bangkok, your method is obviously unsuited to your objectives.
- d. The methodology should also **discuss the problems that were anticipated** and explain the steps taken to prevent them from occurring, and the problems that did occur and the ways their impact was minimized.

The Structure

- Dataset and its collection method
- Framework/Model
- Technical Correctness (mathematical proving – if any)
- Algorithm (if any)
- Example (if any)

3. Results and Discussion

Result

- a. Statement of results: the results are presented in a format that is accessible to the reader (e.g. in a graph, table, diagram or written text). Notice that raw data is usually put in an appendix, if it is included at all.
- b. Explanatory text: all graphs, tables, diagrams and figures should be accompanied by text that guides the reader's attention to significant results. The text makes the results meaningful by pointing out the most important results, simplifying the results, highlighting significant trends or relationships, and perhaps commenting on whether certain results were expected or unexpected.

Discussion

- a. Explanation of results: the writer comments on whether or not the results were expected, and presents explanations for the results, particularly for those that are unexpected or unsatisfactory.
- b. References to previous research: *comparison* of the results with those reported in the literature, or use of the literature to *support* a claim, hypothesis or deduction.
- c. Deduction: a claim for how the results can be applied more generally (a conclusion based on reasoning from the results, e.g. we fed fish a new feed, all the fish gained weight, therefore the new feed causes fish to gain weight).
- d. Hypothesis: a more general claim or possible conclusion arising from the results (which will be proved or disproved in later research).



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4. Conclusion

To give a summary of:

- a. What was learned (this usually comes first)
- b. What remains to be learned (directions for future research)
- c. The shortcomings of what was done (evaluation)
- d. The benefits, advantages, applications of the research (evaluation), and recommendations.

References

- a. Cite the main scientific publications on which your work is based. Cite only items that you have read.
- b. Do not inflate the manuscript with too many references – it doesn't make it a better manuscript.
- c. Avoid excessive self-citations.
- d. Avoid excessive citations of publications from the same region.
- e. Check each reference against the original source (authors name, volume, issue, year, DOI Number).
- f. Carefully follow the journal's instructions to authors.

- You are only given 10 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for question and answer.
- Be conscious of the time.
- Power point must include Introduction of the study, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion and application or recommendation if any.
- 15 to 20 slides is ideal but presenter is given the choice on the number of slides to use for presentation.
Ideally 1 minute per slide.
- Casual Attire for presenter will do, but formal attire would be better.
- All presentation must be uploaded in ASMAC Philippines google drive on or before July 15, 2023. Link will be sent to presenter.
- Schedule of presentation and Abstract will be included in the printed program.

Parallel Session Chair Responsibilities

- The Parallel Session Chair will introduce the paper presenter.
- Must arrive in the session hall ahead of others.
- See to it the readiness of the room.
- Will moderate during the question and answer.
- Should remind the presenter about the time allotment.
- Shall maintain proper decorum of the room.
