- 1 Acquiring a richer and more nuanced knowledge of complex social processes that may elude quantitative research approaches is one of the main strengths of qualitative research. Through qualitative research, researchers can examine participants viewpoints, experiences, and meanings in their own words.
- 2 Flexibility: Qualitative research techniques can be tailored to fit a variety of study contexts and questions. Researchers can gather data in various ways, including interviews, focus groups, and observations, and they can change their strategy when they discover new information.
- 3 Participants are empowered by qualitative research because it honors their perspectives and experiences and includes them in the investigation. As a result, participants may feel more empowered, and power disparities between researchers and participants may be challenged.
- 4 New theory creation: Qualitative research can create or improve new theories. This is so that academics can discover fresh perspectives and understandings that can contradict and broaden previously held beliefs.
- 5 Application to real-world issues: Qualitative research can help with real-world issues and provide information for practice and policy. This is so that treatments and programs can be informed by the rich and intricate insights that qualitative research can offer into the experiences and views of individuals and communities.

What you will learn from this workshop:

- 1 Learn when it is appropriate to use various qualitative research: design, analysis and methods such as case study, phenomenology, and ethnography.
- 2 Learn how to conduct, analyze and report focus group discussions.
- 3 Learn Freeware in sentiment analysis, word cloud, and thematic analysis.
