





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PRE-MEDICAL SUMMIT 2023

ACTIVITIES: The pre-medical summit will be divided into two main activities that will transpire across two days of the Summit, panel discussions and workshops. There will also be a keynote speaker at the end of each day to synthesize the event and provide inspiration to the students who aspire to pursue the field of medicine after college.

1. Panel Discussions in Pre-Medical Courses

The organization will invite several speakers, medical students and/or medical professionals, who studied traditional and non-traditional degrees as their pre-medical courses in college. The participants of the event will be given the opportunity to raise questions during an open forum that will be directed to the invited speakers. The invited speakers will highlight their experiences with their degrees, as well as its advantages and disadvantages in order to give aid to the students in choosing the degree that they will be interested in.
