

REGIONAL WORKSHOP ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF CONTEXTUALIZED INDEPENDENT LEARNING READINESS TEST (ILRT) FOR JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- 1. In support of the Department of Education's (DepEd) commitment to ensuring equal access for all learners at risk of dropping out of basic education, DepEd Region V through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division will conduct the Workshop on the Development of Contextualized Independent Learning Readiness Test (ILRT) for Junior High School on October 21-26, 2024 at a venue to be announced later.
- 2. The activity aims to develop a contextualized independent learning readiness test to ensure that all Junior High School learners at risk are given access to education through the Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) Program appropriate to their contexts and needs.
- 3. The participants to this activity are the ADM program coordinators, and selected 3 secondary school heads of ADM implementing schools (a total of four participants per division). Participants are expected to be present during the entire duration of the workshop and are requested to bring laptop, extension cord, USB or hard drive, and pocket Wifi.
- 4. All participants are expected to arrive on Day 0, October 21, 2024. The first meal to be served is dinner on Day 0 while the last meal is PM snacks on October 26, 2024.
- 5. Considering that October 26, 2024 falls on a Saturday, participants are entitled of Compensatory Overtime Credit pursuant to DO 53, s. 2003 -Updated guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers and CSC-DBM Joint Circular NO. 3, s. 2004- Non-Monetary Renumeration for Overtime Services Rendered.
- 6. Meals and accommodation shall be charged against Flexible Learning Options-Alternative Delivery Mode (FLO-ADM) Funds, while travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local fund subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
