

Participation is on voluntary basis only.



Regional Chemistry Olympiad (PNCO) 2024 - Region V Selection GENERAL GUIDELINES

A. General Information

- The 23rd Philippine National Chemistry Olympiad (PNCO) 2024 is a high school Chemistry competition spearheaded by the Philippine Federation of Chemical Societies, Inc. (PFCS) to select students that will represent the Philippines in the International Chemistry Olympiad (IChO).
- The Regional Chemistry Olympiad (RCO) Region V Selection is a one-day regional selection that will determine the students who will represent Bicol in the PNCO National finals and get the chance to qualify for the International Chemistry Olympiad (IChO).
- The competition is composed of a written elimination round and a final round. The top ten (10)
 highest scorers for the elimination round will qualify for the final round.
- The top five (5) winners of the final round shall be proclaimed winners and will represent the Bicol Region for the PNCO 2024 National Finals on April 6, 2024.
- Additional activities, such as laboratory demonstrations for students and lecture sessions for coaches will be conducted by the organizers
- BU-RCSMED, BUCS Department of Chemistry, Chemical Science Society (CheSS), and PACT Bicol will facilitate RCO Bicol 2024.

B. Important Information:

- 1. Registration fee: P150.00 per contestant
- 2. Deadline of registration: February 26, 2024
- 3. Regional selection: March 2, 2024 (8:00 AM to 5:00 PM)
- 4. National selection: April 6, 2024

C. Qualifications

- RCO Bicol is open to all public and private schools in the Bicol region.
- The participants must be Filipino citizens enrolled as high school students at the 23rd PNCO 2024
 Regional and National competitions. They must NOT be enrolled/registered as college students
 during the duration of the IChO.
- 3. Students can only participate in the PNCO (and IChO) twice.

D. Registration

- Only one (1) team of at most three (3) students may be sent by each participating school. While
 three contestants can represent their school, only individual scores shall determine the winners.
- A school may have a maximum of three (3) coaches (one coach per student). The coach must be a regular faculty of the same school.
- 3. There will be a pre-registration via Google form. Only one form must be accomplished per school. This may be done by one representative coach. Pre-registration Link: https://bit.ly/3w0FCal
- 4. To be considered officially registered, the following documents must be emailed:
 - 1) Endorsement form of head of school
 - 2) Parents' consent form
 - Proof of payment

Payments:

- Only one payment for all contestants should be made per school, according to the registered contestants. Only one receipt will be issued per school.
- 6. There are three possible payment schemes: 1) Online payment via Land Bank to the designated BU Land Bank account, 2) Over-the-counter payment at any Land Bank branch, 3) Over-the-counter payment at the BUCS Cashier, BUCS Bldg 1, BU Main Campus, Legazpi City. (Bank transactions should ALWAYS be Land Bank to Land Bank. Proof of payment must be scanned)

- The completed forms and proof of payment must be emailed to rco.bicol@gmail.com with the Subject: RCO Bicol Documents_Name of School (e.g., RCO Bicol Documents_KNHS)
- Receipts may be claimed on the day of the olympiad.
- 10.An email confirmation of the school's registration will be sent.
- 11. Changes in the contestants may be allowed provided there is a corresponding endorsement from the head of school.

E. Contest Coverage:

Questions involving more advanced topics may also be included. These advanced topics may cover:

- 1. Solid state and coordination chemistry (e.g. crystal structures, crystal field theory, and isomerism of inorganic complexes)
- Thermodynamics (e.g., gases, liquids, solids, temperature dependence of equilibrium constants, electromotive force, and Gibbs free energy)
- Electrochemistry and electrochemical analysis (amperometry, voltammetry, conductimetry, and potentiometry)
- 4. Kinetics (catalysis, the Arrhenius equation, and integrated rate laws)
- Organic chemistry (stereoisomerism, simple stereocontrolled organic transformations, (4+2)cycloaddition, and (3,3)-sigmatropic rearrangement)
- 6. Spectroscopy (correlation of simple organic structures with their 1H-NMR, 13C-NMR, or IR data)
- Analytical Chemistry (acid-base titrations, complexometric titrations, redox titrations, spectrophotometry, and Beer-Lambert's Law)

F. Contest Proper:

- The competition will be in face-to-face mode and will be held at the BUCS Function Hall, BUCS Bldg. 1, Bicol University-Main Campus, Legazpi City
- On the day of the regional selection, participants and coaches should register at the designated registration desk.
- Contestants and coaches must bring their school IDs. Wearing the proper school uniform is encouraged. For those without school uniforms, any school shirt or white shirt can be worn.
- The participants are allowed to use a scientific calculator EXCEPT a programmable calculator, with
 equation features, and with built-in constants.

Elimination Round

- The elimination round is a 50-item multiple-choice examination taken individually and is good for two hours. Each question is worth one point.
- Any participant who will arrive late will not be given extra time to answer the test items.
- Scratch papers and periodic tables will be provided by the organizer. Only blue or black pens will be allowed.
- Questions regarding the exam shall be addressed only to the assigned proctors. Talking to a fellow contestant will be strictly prohibited.
- 5. Sharing of pens, calculators, and exam materials is strictly not allowed during the examination.
- 6. Coaches are not allowed within the perimeter of the exam area.
- 7. Contestants may take their snacks during the allotted examination period.
- 8. The ten highest-scoring participants will advance to the Final Round.

Final Round

- 1. The scores in the elimination round will not be carried over to the final round.
- 2. The final round is a 10-item free response written test.
- 3. If there is a tie on the top 5 positions, an oral clincher round shall follow to break the tie.

- After the endorsement by the regional coordinators, the top FIVE (5) winners (Champion, 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up, 3rd Runner-up, and 4th Runner-up) will move up to the national level.
- All the participants and coaches will receive certificates of participation. Winners will receive certificates of recognition and their respective coaches, certificates of commendation.
- 3. The highest individual scorer in the elimination round will receive a certificate of Recognition.
- 4. Winners will be announced via the Facebook Page of BU-RCSMED and PACT Bicol Chapter.
