In view of the rainy season, we would like to inform your respective agencies about the prescribed hoisting and display of the Philippine flag according to the "Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines," also known as the Republic Act No. 8491:

Chapter 1, Section 3:

h. "Inclement Weather" shall mean that a typhoon signal is raised in the locality;

Chapter 1, Section 16:

f. The flag shall not be raised when the weather is inclement. If already raised, the flag shall not be lowered.
