

DIVISION YOUTH FOR ENVIRONMENT (YES) CAMP AND TRAINING 2014
"BIKOLANO:Preparado, Makusog, Listo. YES-O Ako!"

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. The contest is open to all registered participant of YES camp.
2. A participant is qualified to compete in any contest whether individual or group provided that he/she is duly registered and provided further that there is no conflict in the schedule.
3. Participants are requested to indicate their contest of interest in the Registration Form.
4. As a rule, an elimination round shall be conducted only when needed.
5. There shall be a contest briefing 15 minutes before the contest proper.
6. Decision of the Board of Judges is final.

SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

A. ENVIRO QUIZ

1. All campers are encouraged to participate in the quiz provided they are in the venue before the start of the contest.
2. English and Filipino shall be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
3. Questions shall focus on environmental facts, laws, current events, initiatives and other subjects related to environment and ecology.
4. Each question shall be read twice by the quiz master. The contestant shall only answer as soon as the quiz master has read the questions twice. Countdown shall start immediately thereafter.
5. Contestants shall be given a maximum of twenty (20) seconds if answer requires computation. Other questions shall only be allotted ten (10) seconds.
6. Pens and answer sheets shall be provided by the organizer. Should the contestant wishes to change an answer, he/she shall cross out the answer so written with only one horizontal line and the new answer shall be written legibly above the crossed out answer. The contestant is allowed to change answer within the time allotted for a particular question.
7. The contestant/s shall raise their pens as soon as the allotted time to answer is over.
8. If applicable, depending on the number of entries, an elimination round shall be held.
9. During the elimination round, failure to answer seven (7) out of ten (10) questions correctly shall disqualify and eliminate the contestant. It shall involve easy, average and difficult questions.
10. For the elimination round, only twenty (20) or less qualifiers shall advance to the finals regardless of school and division representation.

B. ON - THE - SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST

1. One contestant per school should be allowed to join this contest.
2. The poster should revolve around the theme which will be announced by the contest administrator during the contest proper.
3. The medium for artistry will be oil pastel only (any color). The required base paper to be used during the contest is 1/2 white cartolina.
4. All materials should be brought by the participant.
5. Borrowing materials from other contestants shall not be allowed.
6. At the option of the contestants, he/she use pencils to draft sketches of his/her ideas/concepts.
7. The allotted time for the contest is two hours, after which the entries shall be submitted to the contest administrator. Contestants may decide to submit his/her poster earlier without waiting for the lapsed two hours. Late submission shall be deducted 0.5 point for every 1 minute extension.
8. Each poster shall be identified by a number that corresponds to the number and identity of the contestant for the judging process.

9. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Originality of Idea	40%
Relevance to the Theme	40%
Overall Impact	20%

C. SLOGAN MAKING CONTEST

1. One contestant per school should be allowed to join this contest.
2. Only one entry per contestant is allowed.
3. The slogan should revolve around the theme which will be announced by the contest administrator during the contest proper.
4. The slogan should be in Bicol which must be catchy, simple and clear.
5. The slogan shall consist of 5 to 10 words only. A compound word will be considered as one word.
6. The material to write on shall be provided by the organizers. Contestants shall bring their own felt tip marking pen.
7. The allotted time for the contest is one (1) hour, after which the entries shall be submitted to the contest administrator. Contestants may decide to submit his/her slogan earlier without waiting for the lapsed one hour.
8. Each poster shall be identified by a number that corresponds to the number and identity of the contestant for the judging process.

9. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Originality of Idea	40%
Relevance to the Theme	40%
Overall Impact	20%

D. SPEECH CHOIR

1. A **minimum** of five (5) and a maximum of ten (10) students shall compose a group.
2. The piece should revolve on this year's YES Camp theme using mother tongue as the medium of interpretation. The presentation should last for a maximum of five (5) minutes, which shall include the introduction and exit of the performers. The presentation shall be stopped when the time is up.
3. All contestants must memorize and recite their respective piece while doing the interpretation.
4. Musical accompaniment, whether disc-generated or live is not allowed.
5. Props and costumes should be at minimum only and must be made from recycled materials.
6. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Environmental message	40%
Clarity of the delivery of the piece	30%
Precision of movement	20%
Projection and overall impact	10%

E. ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

1. One contestant per school should be allowed to join this contest.
2. It shall be an on the spot essay writing contest. As such, the topic theme shall be announced during the contest proper.
3. The essay must be written in English, consisting of not less than 200 words but not more than 300 words, handwritten on a bond paper provided by the organizer.
4. The essay should be written legibly in blue or black ink only.

5. Contestants shall be given one hour to complete their essay. They shall not be allowed to leave the venue once the contest has officially started.
6. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Content	40%
Relevance to the theme	30%
Unity/Organization of idea	20%
Grammar	10%

F. SAYAWIT PARA SA KALIKASAN

1. A minimum of five (5) and a maximum of twenty (20) participants shall perform during the contest.
2. Dancers and singers shall be considered as performers.
3. The performance must consist of a song and a dance presentation on the environment. Participants must actually sing and dance at the same time using mother tongue as medium of interpretation.
4. The presentation should last for a maximum of five (5) minutes, in which period shall include the introduction and exit of performers.
5. The presentation shall be stopped when time is up.
6. Musical accompaniment for the presentation should be compact generated disc only. No live accompaniment should be allowed.
7. The presentation must have environmental relevance and significance.
8. Props should be at minimum only.
9. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Environmental Relevance/ Message	30%
Voice Quality	20%
Quality/ Precision of Choreography	20%
Originality	20%
Projection and Overall Impact	10%

G. LAKAN AT LAKAMBINI NG KALIKASAN

1. Only one (1) contestant for Lakambini and one (1) contestant for Lakan from each school shall join the search.
2. The candidate must be a registered camp participant.
3. The pageant shall consist of three (3) portions namely:
 - a. Talent Show
(Talent to be presented must have relevance to environmental awareness or cause. The presentation must not exceed five minutes. Only minimum props and costume are allowed.)
 - b. Kalikasan Attire
(Kalikasan attire shall be made on the spot only the materials provided by the organizer. Bringing of pre-made costume is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.)
 - c. Question and Answer
(The questions to be answered must have relevance to the environment.)
4. No professional/private make-up artists allowed during the pageant.
5. Contestants should report to the pageant administrators for name listing and orientation as soon as they arrive on camp.
6. Judging should be based on the following criteria:

Beauty and Personality	30%
Talent and Execution	25%
Intelligence and Wit	25%
Stage Presence	10%

Overall Impact

H. YES-O SPOTLIGHT CONTEST

1. The YES-O Spotlight should touch on the schools implementation of environmental projects as mandated in the YES-O's constitution and by-laws. It shall also feature the organization's plans and success stories on environmental action and initiatives.
2. The spotlight shall consist of pictures appropriately labeled, video clips, and certifications, approved and implemented project proposals, events, publications, reports, write-ups and other materials that comply with number 1.
3. The spotlight must be presented in MS Power point Presentation which may require a mixed number of other applicable programs. The entire presentation shall be recorded in DVD format.
4. The organizer shall only provide LCD projector and a laptop computer during the actual presentation.
5. Depending on the number of contestants, an elimination round shall be conducted.
6. Only those registered members of the school YES-O delegation are required to present the spotlight in five (5) minutes. No time extension shall be allowed. Once the time has lapsed, the presentation shall be stopped. Questions will then be asked by the Board of Judges.
7. Participants shall inform the organizer in advance of their interest to join the contest.
