- 1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 104, s. 2014 re: 3rd Regional Choral Competition, this Office will hold its 3rd Division Choral Competition (children's Choir-Elementary Level) on November 24, 2014 with the theme "Bikolano: Mapagpadangat Dangan Mapanunlog" at the Catanduanes National High School CVS Multipurpose Building, 8:00 o'clock in the morning.
- 2. The objectives of this activity are:
 - a). strengthen the spirit of patriotism and musical appreciation of the Bicolano Culture;
 - b). Enrich and nurture artistic skills of pupils in the art of choral singing;
 - c). Reinforce involvement of stakeholders in the preservation of local culture, customs and traditions:
 - d). Identify potential entries to national choral competitions.
- 3. Expected participants are 1st place winners in the zonal elimination agreed by the District Culture and Arts Coordinators concerned. There should be only ONE entry per zone.

Zone 1

- San Andres and Virac

Zone II

- Bato, San Miguel, Baras and Gigmoto

Zone III

- Viga, Panganiban and Bagamanoc

Zone IV

- Pandan and Caramoran

- 4. The First Place winners in the division level will represent our Division in the upcoming 3rd Regional Choral Competition at the Division of Camarines Sur on December 7-8, 2014.
- 5. There shall be no registration fee. Travel and other incidental expenses of participants and coaches during the competition shall be charged to school's MOOE or PTA fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Cost of materials during the activity shall be charged to Division funds.
- 6. Specific guidelines, mechanics of the contest and the contest piece entitled: when the Saints Go Marching In, are released to the field last October 30, 2014 during the conference of District, Secondary Culture and Arts Coordinators. The specific guidelines for Sining Tanghalan enclosed in Division Memorandum No. 107, s. 2014 dated November 5, 2014 is exclusive for the Special Program in the Arts (SPA) implementing schools only.
- 7. Immediate dissemination and compliance of this memorandum is desired.
