


In consonance with the holding of the **3<sup>rd</sup> Bicol PATIRIBAYAN FESTIVAL** (Secondary Level) at Legazpi City on December 9-11, 2013 per Regional Memorandum No. 152, s. 2013, this division shall conduct its 3<sup>rd</sup> Division PATIRIBAYAN FESTIVAL for the Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) (Secondary Level) at the DepEd Division Office Conference Halls A & C on **November 19, 2013**, with the theme, "**An Bicolano sa Padagos sa Pag-uswag sa Tahaw kan mga Agyat nin Panahon**".
2. This activity aims to discover and nurture the talents of the students and teachers and ultimately to raise academic performance.
3. Authorized to attend and join these contests are the first place winners together with their respective coaches. Those involved in the committee are also enjoined to perform their assigned task and should report to the Division Office the day before, November 18, 2013.
4. The guidelines and criteria for judging which were discussed/ oriented during the planning conference shall be observed in the contest.
5. Registration Fee of the student contestants shall be twenty- five pesos (P25.00) and fifty pesos (P50.00) for the coaches who shall register only once though he/ she may be a coach of several students/ contestants.
6. Events to be contested; mechanics, guidelines, and criteria for judging; and working committees are found in the enclosures.
7. Travel and other expenses relative to the conduct of these contests shall be charged to school/ local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Dimension	EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAKATAO
Areas of Exhibition	A. Photo Reflection Contest B. Project Proposal Making C. Poster Making Contest
Description	The events for <i>Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao</i> intends to showcase learned knowledge, skills and attitudes in the subject that are geared towards lifelong learning.
Participants	A. Photo Reflection Contest – A Grade 7 or Grade 8 Student who won in the same event in the Division Level. Only one contestant will be allowed to represent each school division.
	B. Project Proposal Making – A Team of four members composed of a Grade 7, a Grade 8, a Third Year and a Fourth Year student. Only one team will be allowed to represent each school division.
	C. Poster Making Contest – A Student from any year level who won in the same event in the Division Level. Only one contestant will be allowed to represent each school division.
Levels of Exhibition	A. Division Level – Scheduled by Schools Division B. Regional Level – December 9, 2013
Exhibition Mechanics	A. Photo Reflection Contest <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The contest is open to Grade 7 or Grade 8 students</li> <li>• One picture will be exhibited to all the contestants</li> <li>• The contestants will be asked to reflect on the picture using the skills learned in ESP classes</li> <li>• <b>The language to be used in the contest is Filipino</b></li> <li>• One hour is allotted for the reflection writing activity</li> <li>• Each contestant will be allowed to write his/her reflection in a maximum of two pages of yellow paper</li> <li>• The Judges' decision is final and irrevocable</li> </ul>
	B. Project Proposal Making <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The contest is a Team Event.</li> <li>• Each team is composed of students from each year level (Grade 7, Grade 8, Third Year and Fourth Year)</li> <li>• The contestants will be asked to prepare a project proposal containing <u>at least two</u> strategies on how values may be advocated in their school</li> <li>• <b>The language that will be used in the proposal making is English</b></li> <li>• The same format of project proposal will be used by all teams. It will be provided by the EPS In-charge of ESP from the regional office <b>(Please see attached proposal format)</b></li> <li>• Two hours are allotted for the project proposal writing activity</li> <li>• Each team will be allowed to write their proposal in sheets of yellow paper</li> <li>• The Judges' decision is final and irrevocable</li> </ul>

Exhibition Mechanics	<p>C. Poster Making Contest</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The contest is open to a student coming from any year level</li> <li>• The contestants will be asked to make a poster on the theme of the <i>Patiribayan 2013</i> highlighting values that may be drawn from students in the conduct of the festival</li> <li>• One hour and a half is allotted for the poster making activity</li> <li>• Each contestant will be provided a ¼ illustration board and a set of oil pastel where he could create the poster</li> <li>• The Judges' decision is final and irrevocable</li> </ul>
