DIVISION INSTRUCTIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR SCIENCE TEACHERS (DIDPST) (SECONDARY)

To: Secondary School Heads

- In keeping with the Division Targets on the Improvement of Students' Performance Level in Science and Technology a Division Instructional Development Program for Science Teachers will be conducted every 2nd Friday of the month starting September, 2013 until January, 2014. The 1st DIDPST will be conducted at Calatagan High School, Virac, Catanduanes starting at 8 A.M.
- 2. This DIDPST aims to enhance the secondary science teachers' content knowledge, skill and will to develop the scientific literacy among students that will prepare them to be informed and participative citizen who are able to make judgment and decisions regarding application of scientific knowledge that may have social, health or environmental impacts.

- 4. A registration of two hundred fifty pesos (Php 250.00) shall be charged to each participant to cover for food (two (2) snacks and one (1) lunch) and training materials.
- 5. Registration fee, travel and other incidental expenses relative to this training shall be charged against school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
