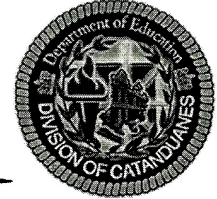

**ALL HEADS OF SCHOOLS WITH NGP CONTRACTS**



A team of Division Personnel will be visiting your schools on March 24-28, 2014 to monitor the progress of your catch-up activities.

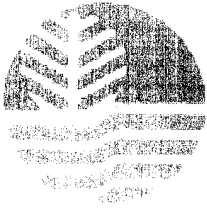

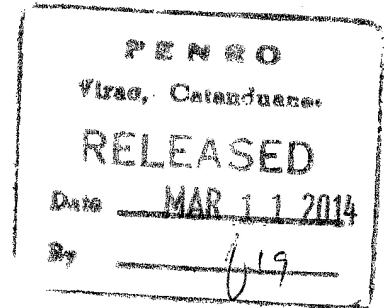

Greetings!

This has reference with our letter dated November 21, 2013 re: Requesting Assistance in the Conduct of Monitoring and Supervision to some schools awarded with Contracts under the National Greening Program (NGP).

We would like to inform you that per assessment and validation conducted by our technical personnel, revealed that some schools awarded with Plantation Maintenance and Protection Contracts for CY 2012 and 2013 showed low survival rate and below the required survival rate of 85% on their established plantations in CY 2011.

Relative to this, may we respectfully reiterate our request for assistance in the monitoring of schools within NGP sites for the continuous and regular maintenance and protection activities such as replanting, ringweeding, fertilizer application, etc. to attain a higher survival rate. We had an assigned Extension Officers to regularly monitor schools awarded with NGP projects.
